Young Theatre Makers is based within a school and is focussed on using theatre as a way of building community, boosting confidence and communication skills as well as having a creative outlet. Whereas the Youth Company takes place outside of school in a professional studio space and is tailored towards those already interested in theatre, who want to develop their performance and theatre skills.

Beyond Face is a professional theatre company and by engaging with us, you become a part of our company. Our young people are continually feeding into our vision and shaping the work we create. Our sessions are led by industry professionals of the Global Majority and you will get the chance to visit/perform in professional spaces and stay up to date with all our other opportunities.

We offer a space specifically for young people of the Global Majority so that they can come together and feel seen, heard and celebrated and be in a community of Global Majority artists in what is a predominantly white area.

No, it's completely FREE! Our Young Theatre Makers and Youth Company sessions are funded by Plymouth University Widening Participation, meaning there is no cost for young people to attend our sessions - which is fantastic!
